On the occasion of the Janjatiya

Gaurav Divas, marking the birth anniversary of tribal icon Birsa Munda, Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged off the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra from Khunti, Jharkhand. 5 specially designed IEC (Information, Education and Communication) Vans carrying messages of Government's flagship welfare programmes moved to various Gram Panchayats with significant tribal population located in Khunti district and nearby areas.

Similar IEC vans were flagged off by important dignitaries like Governors, Chief Ministers, Union Ministers, Ministers of State from 68 districts across the country with significant tribal population.

In Jammu & Kashmir the Sankalp Yatra was flagged off from Budhal and Gurez areas of Rajouri and Bandipora districts respectively. Braving cold winds at 8,000 feet above mean sea level, locals, youth, Panchayat Raj institutions and government officials attended the launch function. Lt. Governor Manoi Sinha participated in the event via video conferencing.

Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Lt Gen K T Patnaik (Retd) flagged



off the IFC vans at 7iro in Lower Subansiri district. The beneficiaries of PM SVANidhi, PM Awas Yojana attended the ceremonial launch function. The IEC vans will travel in Lower Subansiri, Tawang and East Kameng districts spreading public awareness about government's welfare schemes at the grass root level. In Nagaland, the campaign was launched at Indisen village of Dimapur district. In adjoining Assam the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra was launched at Baksa, Kokrajhar and Karbi Anglong.

The Governor of Maharashtra Shri Ramesh Bains and Chief Minister Shri Eknath Shinde attended the launch event in the tribal district of Nandurbar. Union Minister Shri Purshottam Rupala attended the event in Dahod, Gujarat while the state Chief Minister Shri Bhupendra Patel flagged off the vans at Ambaji. Union Minister Bishweshwar Tudu flagged off the Viksit Bharat campaign vans from the Mayurbhani district of Odisha.

Themes covered

The focus of the Yatra will be on reaching out to people and create awareness and providing benefits of welfare schemes like sanitation facilities, essential financial services, electricity connections, access to LPG cylinders, housing for the poor, food security, proper nutrition, reliable healthcare, clean drinking water, etc.

Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra Gets a Massive Response

In a grand start, the first day of the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra reached more than one lakh people across 259 Gram Panchayats in the country.

The campaign was flagged off by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on November 15, 2023, at Khunti. Jharkhand with multiple vans launched simultaneously from various locations with significant tribal population across the country.

A dynamic melange of events and initiatives unfolded on the first day of the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra, weaving together stories of empowerment and collective engagement toward a shared vision of national development.

People thronged the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra IEC Vans and enthusiastically participated in the activities organized as well as availed of the on-spot services provided. More than 16,000 people participated in Health Camps organized with over 6,000 people screened for TB, and over 4500 for Sickle cell disease on the first day.

The aim of the Yatra is to generate awareness regarding the Central government's welfare schemes and policies and achieve 100% saturation of flagship government schemes. In line with this objective, over 21000 people registered for the PM Ujjwala

Yojana on the very first day of the Yatra.

The Yatra is a testimony to India's resolve to develop and acknowledge the role and responsibility shared by the citizens in this endeavour. Over 1200 My Bharat volunteers were registered along with more than 80,000 people who pledged allegiance to the transformative "Sankalp Pledge". The Yatra, on the first day, also spotlighted remarkable individuals-3,448 women, 1,475 students, 495 local artists, and 298 sports personalities—recognizing their efforts and acknowledging them as inspiring figures.

Drone demonstration is a big hit The Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra shall also showcase development in the agriculture field that can be leveraged by the farmers to increase their production and productivity. On day 1, over 120 drone demonstrations and Soil Health Card demonstrations were organized. There was an engaging interaction with farmers who practice Natural Farming.

Of the 259 Gram Panchavats covered on day 1, 83 have 100% Ayushman Card saturation, 89 have 100% JJM saturation. 97 have 100% Jan Dhan saturation, and 124 have achieved the ODF+ status.

Yogi govt focuses on promoting religious tourism in Uttar Pradesh



n line with its efforts to promote religious tourism in Uttar Pradesh, the Yogi government is working on the beautification and development of various pilgrimage sites of religious, spiritual and historical importance in the state. In this sequence, a detailed action plan has been prepared as per the intention of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and the process of implementation has been started by Uttar Pradesh State Tourism **Development Corporation Limited** (UPSTDC).

The UPSTDC has started beautification and development works on a total of 10 places of religious importance, including Kali Mata Temple, Jharkhandi Temple and Shri Ram Janaki Temple in Basti, Kalika Temple in Azamgarh and Siddhpeeth Mata Mansharani Temple in Unnao and Kali Temple, Seth Ghat and Baba Banwari Das Dham in Lakhimpur and Dhopeshwar Nath Temple in Bareilly.

It is worth noting that the completion of beautification and long-term development work at these places will not only boost tourism to these pilgrimage sites, but will also contribute to the overall progress of the region.

Pilgrimage sites of 5 districts including Basti will be rejuvenated

The Uttar Pradesh State Tourism Development Corporation Limited (UPSTDC) has started a beautification and development drive for pilgrimage sites in five districts, including Basti and Lakhimpur. In Basti, the Vikramjot village's Jharkhandi Temple, Dubkhara's Kali Mata Temple, and Repura's Shri Ram-Janaki Temple are prioritized for beautification and development. UPSTDC has initiated an e-tendering process to select companies and agencies for implementing these projects.

Similarly, the development process has begun for Mata Kalika Temple in Harkhori, located in Azamgarh, and for Siddhapeeth Mata Mansarovar Temple in Unnao. Additionally, the beautification and development process of the Buddhist pilgrimage site in Naval Jatapur, has also begun through the allocation process.

5000-year old **Dhopeshwar Nath** temple will be rejuvenated

The Yogi government is also preparing to start rejuvenation of the Dhopeshwarnath Temple. The temple, located in the cantonment area of Bareilly, is not just a religious pilgrimage site but also a witness to many historical events.

It is believed that Dhrum Rishi, the guru of Draupadi, meditated here during the Dvapara Yuga, around 5000 years ago. During his meditation, he established a Shiva Lingam here, and since then, the temple got the name Dhopeshwarnath. Some devotees also refer to it as Dhopa Mandir.

Similarly, Seth Ghat in Lakhimpur, Baba Banwari Das Dham in Bankegani and Kali Mata Temple in Mohammadi village of Padsar are also significant pilgrimage sites with their own unique stories. All these pilgrimage sites are set for a facelift through building of infrastructure, installation of facilities devotees and tourists, as well as beautification.



Deepotsav **Ayodhya**

n the auspicious occasion of Diwali, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath arrived in Ayodhya and began his day by visiting Shri Hanumangarhi. Following this, he proceeded to Shri Ram Janmabhoomi, where he offered prayers to Lord Ram Lalla, seeking blessings for the well-being and happiness of the people.

While interacting with the saints, the Chief Minister said. "Curfew used to be imposed here in the 90s, but now the world is getting attracted towards Ayodhya."

Furthermore, CM Yogi convened a meeting with the saints at Karsevakapuram to discuss the consecration of the Ram temple. He also joined the saints for breakfast and extended Diwali wishes.

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said that Ayodhya has witnessed the spread of positive energy through Deepotsav. He congratulated the residents of Ayodhya on setting a world record with the Deepotsav program.

The Chief Minister further said, "Ramlala is going to be seated in the grand Shri Ram temple in Ayodhya in the coming month of January. There is excitement and enthusiasm among the saints regarding this. All the saints are determined to participate in the inauguration program of the grand temple of Ramlala."

It is worth noting that the seventh edition of the Deepotsav program, under the leadership of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, broke all the previous records by illuminating

22 lakh 23 thousand lamps, once again establishing a world record.

On the second day of his visit to Ayodhya, the Chief Minister visited the Shri Ramlala temple on Sunday morning for darshan and also offered prayers at Hanumangarhi.

Diwali in Gorakhpur

After creating a new world record for the festival of lights with the lighting of more than 22 lakh diyas in Ayodhya, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath celebrated Diwali among the forest dwellers on Sunday, continuing the tradition that he himself started about one and a half decade ago.

The Chief Minister also inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of a total of 52 development projects worth Rs 153 crore for different gram panchayats of Gorakhpur district on the occasion.

Sharing the joy of Diwali with members of the Vantangiya community in Tikonia No. 3 village in Kusamhi forest, the Chief Minister also remembered the struggle for the rights of Vantangiyas, pointing out that any struggle done in a positive spirit never goes in vain. He said that the struggle for the Vantangiya community was fought in this spirit and today its positive outcome is visible. Yogi added that Diwali and Ramrajya are all about "providing all the government facilities and civil rights to the underprivileged."

Addressing the gathering, the Chief Minister said that he was very happy to see the pucca houses of the poor as well as drinking water facilities, electricity, good schools and Anganwadi centers

in Vantangiya village. He remarked: "Everyone must have seen the grand Deepotsav of Ayodhya yesterday. Just as Ayodhya is getting decorated, similarly villages of Uttar Pradesh, Gorakhpur and Vantangiya are also getting decorated."

ahats.


