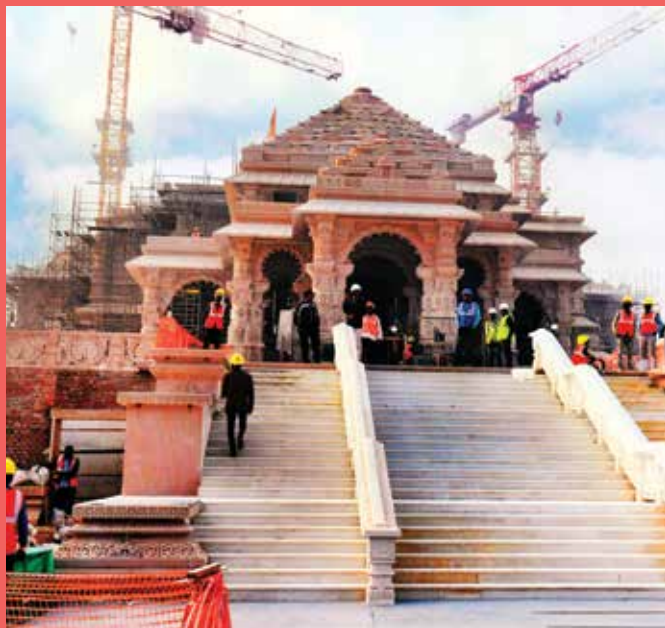
In line with the state government's efforts, the Ayodhya Development Authority (ADA) is working to adorn the walls of all major routes leading to the Ram Janmabhoomi temple with terracotta fine clay murals. Simultaneously, the ADA has also initiated the work of embellishing the walls of all major routes leading to the Ram Janmabhoomi temple with artifacts made of pebbles and stones.

The process of determining the agency to complete this work is underway and it is believed that this work will be completed before the PranPratishtha program. It is worth noting that ADA aims to actively contribute to increasing tourism in the city of Ayodhya and is focused on developing Ayodhya as the global spiritual capital by 2047.

Furthermore, meaningful efforts are being made to create a state-of-the-art infrastructure in Ayodhya, aiming to blend its ancient heritage with modernity. This initiative is expected to transform the city into a vibrant fusion of antiquity and modernity.



Artworks are being installed on major routes in Ayodhya



According to ADA, terracotta artworks and murals are being installed along the Dharm Path, depicting various events related to Lord Shri Ram's life. These include scenes from Shri Ram's court, the killing of Khar-Dushan, and Kaikeyi's 'kopabhavangaman' scene. This blend of tradition and modernity serves as a symbol that welcomes pilgrims and visitors to experience the timeless charm of Ayodhya.

The Dharma Path is becoming a prominent attraction for numerous pilgrims and travelers seeking spiritual tranquility. The installation of terracotta murals along the roadside has transformed it into a captivating selfie point. These murals act as visual storytellers, depicting sacred legends, epics, and stories that have left an indelible mark on the heart of Ayodhya over the centuries. This initiative not only provides a cultural guidepost for pilgrims but also bridges the gap between the sacred past and the dynamic present, enhancing the spiritual journey for those who traverse this path.

Not only do these murals serve as artistic expressions, but they also enhance knowledge, understanding, and unity. They contribute to the beautification of the city and function as an open-air gallery.

Terracotta sculptures are giving a grand look to the historic city circuit



The installation of terracotta murals aligns with the ADA's strategy for the Historical City Circuit and Heritage Walk. By integrating art, heritage, and basic infrastructure, this initiative fulfills the strategic objective of creating a place that instills a sense of pride and belonging equally among residents and visiting pilgrims. Additionally, this project directly contributes to ADA's goals of promoting cultural tourism and establishing Ayodhya as a global tourism destination.

In this sequence, the height of 50 mural sculptures and mural paintings to be made has been fixed at 9 feet and width at 20 feet. Their themes will be based on different Ramayana episodes. They will be crafted using riverbed fine clay, and the selected clay for these artworks will be free from urea and salt to prevent corrosion. The baking (firing) of these artworks will be done at temperatures ranging from 970 to 1050 degrees. The relief of the murals will be 8 inches and each part, piece, and block will be applied to the wall with polymer mortar, with a final coat of weather-resistant paint applied.

Creation of 20 artifacts from pebbles and stones underway

Likewise, artifacts crafted from pebbles and stones are set to stand at an impressive height of 9 feet and a width of 20 feet. There is a plan to construct a total of 20 such artifacts along the Dharma Path.

The target is to complete the construction of these artworks in two months, but the focus is on completing the artifacts along the main path before January 22. To achieve this goal, focus is also being put on completing the process of determining the agency as soon as possible so that the completion of these construction works can be expedited.



Development in the year 2023

The holy city of Ayodhya, also known as Avadhpuri, witnessed large scale development works in 2023, and is set to regain its glory under the guidance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and effective execution of projects by Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath. After five hundred years of waiting, struggles, and movements, finally, on the upcoming January 22, 2024, Lord Shri Ram will be enshrined in his new, majestic, and divine temple in Ayodhya.



The year 2024 is poised to be the most significant year in the history of Ayodhya, but when the evaluation of the year 2023 is done in the future, undoubtedly, it will be considered the foundational year for the restoration of Ayodhya's glory.

In 2023, a long list of development projects was undertaken for the transformation of Ayodhya. The most significant efforts were directed towards strengthening the connectivity of the city dedicated to Lord Shri Ram. On one hand, an International Airport was constructed to connect Ayodhya with the entire world and on the

other, the Ayodhya Dham Railway Station was renovated for the convenience of railway passengers.

Significant efforts were made to enhance road connectivity through four different routes as well as to beautify the city in a way so as to represent the blend of its rich religious heritage and state-of-the-art facilities for devotees and tourists in 2023. Under the guidance of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, development work is ongoing for the comprehensive development of Avadhpuri, aiming to turn it into a prosperous city and a city of abundance once again.

Round the globe events have been planned in various parts of the world to mark the Ram temple consecration ceremony on January 22. These programmes are either being organised by the Vishwa Hindu Parishad (VHP) or are being undertaken by Hindu diaspora groups.

Canada: Ayodhya Ram Mandir Day

Preparations are in full swing for the upcoming Pran Pratishtha (consecration) ceremony at the Ram Mandir in Ayodhya, scheduled for January 22, 2024. The significance of the event extends beyond the world's most populous nation as the towns of Oakville and Brampton in Ontario, Canada, have officially declared January 22, 2024, as "Ayodhya Ram Mandir Day."

United States of America: Dozen of week long events

Approximately 1,000 temples across the United States are organising events, including car rallies, cultural programs, and religious ceremonies, to commemorate this historic occasion. The celebration will begin with the Sundarkand, followed by cultural programmes of dance, singing, and music. This will be followed by a havan and Lord Ram's Pattabishek, culminating in a procession of Lord Ram and prasad (food) distribution.

Tesla Musical Light show in Maryland

The VHP of America organized a Tesla Musical light show in Maryland, with over 150 cars on January 14. Synchronized to the tune of 'Jai Shri Ram' it showcased the creativity of Hindu Community.

Billboards across the US

Over 40 billboards featuring Lord Ram and the Ram Temple have been erected in over 10 states in the United States

Time Square, New York

Devotees in New York will assemble at Time square on January 22, while in Washington DC, the VHP organized a car and bike rally at the Shree Bhakta Anjaneya Temple

on January 20.

Mauritius: 2 hours break

In a significant move, the Mauritian Government has decided to grant a one-off special leave for two hours to public servants of the Hindu faith to attend prayers marking the "landmark" inauguration of Ram Temple in Ayodhya on January 22.

Paris: Global Rath Yatra

In Paris, a Ram Rath Yatra will be carried out from place de la Capelle to the iconic Eiffel Tower, featuring chanting of "Shree Ram Dhun", devotional songs, cultural programs and Prasad distribution.

Australia: celebration of festivity

In Australia program will be organized in Western Sydney and Melbourne, along with the events in Brisbane, Perth, Adelaide and New South Wales.

Africa: Time of Joy

In Africa, car rallies and other programs are planned in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Ghana, Nigeria, and Mozambique.

United Kingdom: Diwali vibes in January

Diaspora organisations across the UK are gearing up for the big day with devotional and social events arranged around the country. The weekend long devotional events – from January, 20 to 21 – will hold devotional activities like bhajans, kirtans, night-long singing of devotional songs and a 'Vishesh Ramcharan Puja'.

As well as this free event which promises to be a spiritual and devotional respite for those who attend, a diaspora initiative has seen a new website set up with the sole purpose of keeping the British Indian community informed about events related to the Ayodhya Ram Mandir across the UK. The site – namely 'UK Celebrates Ayodhya Ram Mandir' – lists several dozen events in various parts of the country.
